

## Experience Bhutan is the dragon kingdom the Land of the Thunder Dragon: 5 days 4 nights

### Day 1 : Bangkok – Bhutan /Paro

- 04:00** Meet the tourist at Suvarnabhumi Airport, Departure terminal, 4th floor, gate 10, counter W, with the company's stuff to welcome and facilitate.
- 06:50** Fly to Bhutan by Druk airline flight number KB...by stopover to pick up passengers at Kowahati (India) about 45 minutes, which passengers don't have to leave the plane.
- 10:15** The first day flight to Paro Airport will bring you the most spectacular view of the Himalayan Ranges. 25 minutes before you land into the Dragon Kingdom, you will be able to view the highest mountain range, the Mount Everest and the other Mountains like the Mount Kanchenjunga, Mount Makalu and then later on the mountains of Bhutan like the Famous Mount Jomolhahri, Mount Jichu Drake, Mount Tshering Gang etc. and finally you reach the airport after 3 hrs. 20 min flight from Bangkok.
- (Local time in Bhutan is 1 hours behind Thailand)
- The guide will pick up you at the airport and then proceed to Haven Paro Resort, relax and have lunch at the resort.
- 13:00** In the afternoon, we will go to Paro Rinpung Dzong, which means jewel fortress, Rinpung Dzong is a large dzong - Buddhist monastery and fortress - of the Drukpa Lineage of the Kagyu school in Paro District, Bhutan. It houses the district Monastic Body and government administrative offices of Paro Dzongkhag. It is listed as a tentative site in Bhutan's Tentative List for UNESCO inclusion. Next visit at Kyichu Lhakhang which is the oldest temple in Bhutan, believed to have been built in 659 by King Songtsen Gampo of Tibet to subdue the demons. Stroll around the Paro Town for shopping and Leisure.
- 18:00** Go back at the Haven Paro Resort.

### Day 2 : Paro – Punakha

- 07:30** Have early breakfast at Haven Paro Resort.
- 08:30** In the morning, have breakfast at resort, and drive to Thimphu, the capital city of Bhutan. Have lunch at Thimphu and go shopping, we visit the National Memorial Chorten which is an impressive monument with its golden spires shining in the sun, its bells tinkling in the wind and an endless procession of elderly people circling around it. The Memorial Chorten was built in 1974 in memory of the third King, Jigme Dorji Wangchuck. There are no mortal remains of the King inside the Chorten. There is only a photograph draped in ceremonial scarves on the ground floor. The ceilings of the small porches that grace all four sides of the Chorten

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floor. The ceilings of the small porches that grace all four sides of the Chorten are painted on the south with the mandala of the Buddha Ratnasambhava, on the west with that of Hayagriya, on the north with the mandala of Phurba and on the east with that of Vajrasattava. The Memorial Chorten is an excellent introduction to Trantic Buddhism.

12:00

Have lunch.

13:00

After that we visit Dechen Phrodrang, meaning "Palace of Great Bliss". It is a Buddhist monastery in Thimphu, Bhutan. It is located in the north of the city. Next visit to the Takin Zoo, Takin as the national animal of Bhutan is dated to the 15th century. And then bring you to Centenary Farmer's Market is a two story building with about 400 stalls that provides farmers from around the country the opportunity to display their products and people a chance to support the local agriculture. Vendors from throughout the region start arriving on Thursday and Friday, and remain till Sunday night. The best time to explore the market is within these three days when the rush of trade is going on. It is also a great way to get acquainted with the locals and learn about the ingredients of a Bhutanese diet. Also watch the residents' horde the market, choosing the best of the season's product. Shopping at handicraft shops.

18:00

Dinner and rest at Ariya Hotel.

### Day 3 : Thimphu - Paro

07:00

Have breakfast at resort.

08:00

Drive to Dochula, Punakha, which is at 3,150 m. (pass). On a clear day, you can see the Himalayan Ranges.

13:00

After that go to the Punakha Dzong, you can see Wandiphodrang dzong on the way sightseeing at Punakha town.

16:00

Go back to dinner and rest at Haven Paro Resort.

### Day 4 : Thimphu - Paro

07:00

Have early breakfast at Haven Paro Resort.

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08:00

And then drive to Paro Taktshang or the Tigers Nest. It is perched on a 900 m. cliff above the ground of the Paro Valley. As believed by the Bhutanese the Guru Rinpoche, a very famous Buddhist Saint, had come to this area on the back of a flying tigress and meditated there and subdued the Demons. This is in fact a very holy place for pilgrimage in Bhutan.

This program can choose to walk or ride a dwarf horse. (Approximate cost of 800 Ngultrum, which is not included in the tour package) By riding up only, in return you have to walk down on your own.

Please inform 1 day in advance. Going up to Takshang. In case of traveling by foot is about 3 hours. In case of riding donkey up is about 45 minutes or 1 hour (depending on the condition of each person's body) and have to walk for another 1 hour. Going down must walk only, it takes about 1:30-2 hrs.

Unless you won't to visit Taktshang. We will bring you to see Drukyl Dzong, an old fortress on the top of the mountain. Located at the point of controlling the path to Tibet Built in 1644 to commemorate the victory over Tibet.

You will see a secret route to escape from the fortress. When the Tibetans invaded the fort and the soldiers went down to use the water in the fort, you can see Tibet and the Julolahari Mountains or the "Mountains of God" with a height of 7,315 meters from sea level and is a viewpoint of the peak of "Jumol Haari", Jomolhari, Duntse Temple or the Dark Temple, built in 1421 by the Tibetan monk named "Thang Thangelpo" Is a temple with collect beautiful painting various of gods. Or choose to relax at the hotel (Hot Stone Bath service), which is a hot water bath for health. And relaxation in the traditional wooden tub of Bhutanese people by bringing the stone to burn the fire and put it in a water bath to generate heat which Bhutanese believe that the rock will release the minerals that are beneficial to the body to make it healthy

16:00

Travel to Paro for Shopping.

18:00

Bring you back to Haven Paro Resort and have dinner. And rest at leisure.

### Day 5 : Paro - Bangkok

07:00

Have breakfast at Haven Paro Resort.

08:00

Check out from resort and go to Paro Airport for check-in ticket.a

10:35

Departure from Paro Airport to Bangkok by Druk Air and stopover to pick up passengers at Kolkata (India) about 45 minutes, which passengers don't have to leave the plane.

16.05

Reach to Bangkok safely.
